Life and Legacy of Marian "Bernice" Poston

"Bernice" attended Indianapolis Public Schools and graduated from Crispus Attucks High School with the class of 1960. While attending Crispus Attucks High School she was a member of the NAACP and a Community Activist.

After graduating "Bernice" attended and graduated from Porter Business College thereafter becoming a Key punch Operator at Fort Benjamin Harrison's Army Finance Center.
