Obituary

In 1990’s, *Rosa* became a member of Eastern Star Church, where she and her husband were active leaders of the marriage couple home ministries. She also was a Greeter at the church.

Rosa was a devoted wife and mother. She was loving, patient and kind. She passed on a gentle spirit with her warm smile. *Rosa* had excellent listening skills and would share life lessons that would bless people. This gift of counseling was truly her ministry. When she was not counseling, she enjoyed knitting, sewing and crocheting for family and other people.
