

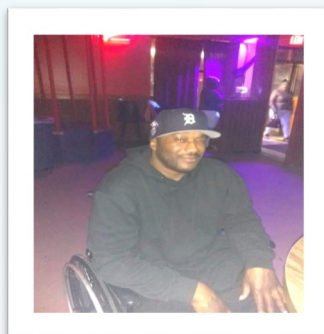
**THINKING OF YOU ON THE DAY
