

LIFE STORY MARCELLUS

A TIME TO BE BORN - Marcellus Dawson was born on July 15 in the year of 1935 to Emma Robinson and Charlie Dawson in Old Town, Florida, known to many as "Black Jack".

A TIME TO BE EDUCATED - Mr. Dawson was educated in the Dixie County Public School System where he received his High School Diploma from Oliver High School.

A TIME TO FIND LOVE - In 1960 at the age of 25, after growing up with the love of his life, Mr. Marcellus Dawson married Ms. Elizabeth Simmons. 3 children were born of this union. Mr. & Mrs. Dawson were married for 55 years until she preceded him in death in 2015.

A TIME TO SERVE - Mr. Dawson served in many capacities throughout his life. He served in the United States Army. Mr. Dawson also served the people of Cross City, Fl as the Chief of Police for several years and as a city councilman. A time to find Christ - Mr. Dawson gave his life over to the Lord Jesus Christ back in the 80's under the gospel ministry of the late Bishop J.P. Jenkins. On August 12, 2005, Mr. Dawson accepted the Holy call to the gospel ministry and walked in his calling as a Minister in Christ's Kingdom under the leadership of Overseer Ruby L. Graham. He was a faithful member and servant at Refuge Church of God until his health began to decline.
