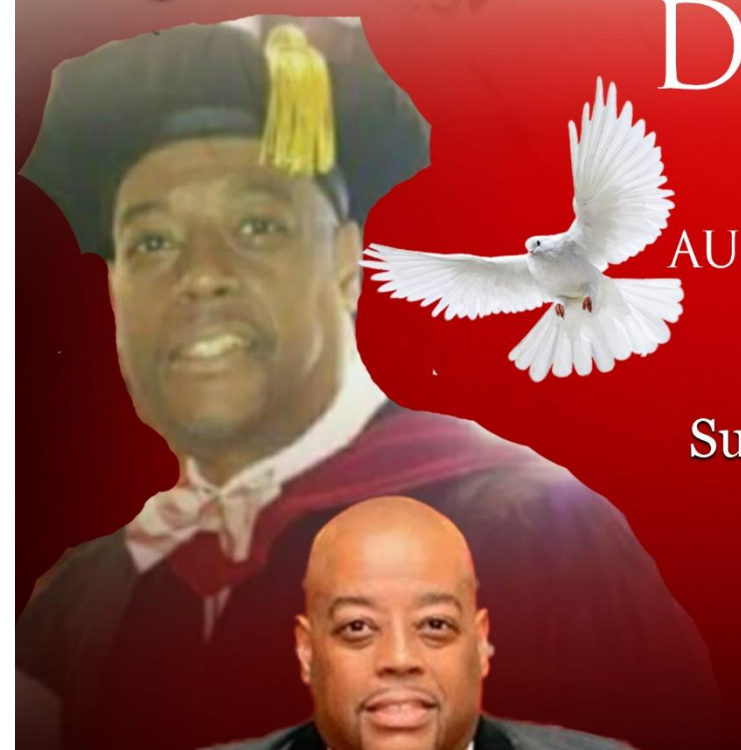

Dr. Kerwin Dale Williams

He is known to be like “David, the king”, a man after God’s own heart.

Dr. Kerwin D. Williams was born on August 15, 1968, at Brookdale Hospital in Brooklyn, NY at approximately 10:00 a.m. Kerwin was the son of Delores Williams Belizaire and the late Harry L. Williams. He was the youngest of three children.

He was educated in the New York City and South Carolina School Systems. He attended Jamaica High School, Queens, NY, and graduated from Wagener-Salley High School, Wagener, SC. He continued to further his education at Benedict College and Administrative School Building Leadership at St. John’s University, Queens, NY. Dr. Williams earned a B.A. degree in Religious Studies from Anointed by God Theological Seminary. He attended New Greater Bethel Bible Institute, where he studied Priesthood Consecration I and II, under the guidance of Dr. Caswell Morgan. In October 2007, Dr. Williams was licensed as an Ordained Reverend and Chaplain at the Anointed by God Theological Seminary and Vision from the Heart Ministries.

In his formative years, he was a member of the Brownsville Community Baptist Church, Brooklyn, NY, under the leadership of Reverend Harold Burton, Sr. It was there where Dr. Williams accepted Jesus Christ as his personal savior. He served faithfully on the joint board of ushers and sang on the Junior and Young Adult Choirs. Where ever the Lord sent him, he was very active in the up building of God’s kingdom in song and service. He has served in the following ministries: Beulah Church of Our Lord Jesus Christ, under the leadership of Bishop Wilbur L. Jones, Sr., where he received the gift of the “holy ghost” with the evidence of speaking in tongues, and the Brooklyn Tabernacle Delieverence Center, under the leadership and tutelage of the late Bishop James F. Copeland, his mentor. He also sung with various recording artists in the New York City areas.

In November 1997, Dr. Williams relocated to South Carolina and served at the Chalk Hill Baptist Church, under the leadership of Reverend John Dingle and Reverend Ronnie Tyler. He served faithfully as Inspirational Choir President, Sunday School Teacher, and Trustee. While in South Carolina, he began his educational career. He was employed with the Aiken and Orangeburg County School Systems. He collaborated with the Aiken County Public School System and the Crescent Cities Parenting Center, where he wrote a grant and received \$10,000 from the Sisters of Charity Foundation to rebuild the Crescent Cities Park in Salley, South Carolina. He also organized a mentorship initiative for adolescents, which earned him statewide recognition with the South Carolina Fatherhood Initiative Program.

For over two decades, Dr. Williams has been committed to the cause of educating a nation. He educates youth in the areas of discipline, integrity, and determination. Dr. Williams was the Guidance Director/Counselor and College Advisor to the high school students at Bethel Christian Academy, Queens Village, NY. He assists students in their college search and has been a great instrument in getting them into such institutions as, Morehouse College, Spelman College, and St. John’s University, just to name a few. His passion for educating youth led him to begin his own organization Y.M.E., Young Men’s Empowerment, an organization which assist youth in their college aspirations. He is known as the “Scholarship Specialist”.

He has been the recipient of the NEXTSTEP magazine Counselor of the Year for two consecutive years. He was named Educator of Distinction in the National Society of High School Scholars. In May 2016, because of his service in the community, church, and school, he earned his honorary doctorate degree in Divinity from the Anointed by God Theological Seminary.

Dr. Williams relocated to Atlanta, Georgia, where he was an associate minister at the Powerful Praise Tabernacle, under the leadership of Bishop Elect Darryl Hill.

Dr. Williams is the recipient of many distinguished awards, citations, honors, and received a proclamation from the state senate of New York in December 2017 and is a member of various religious, educational, and social action organizations.

His Motto is “Only What You Do for Christ Will Last!”.

Kerwin leaves the following to be remembered and celebrate his life of legacy: his loving mother, Delores Belizaire; his stepfather whom he called “Dad”, Alberto Belzaire, Sr.; King Jaiden Benn, who was a special blessing as a son, he never had; siblings, Nathlie Holland, Harry Williams, Jr., Kevin Williams, Gina Belizaire, Karen Williams, Renee Belizaire, and Alberto Belizaire, Jr.; aunt, Elizabeth Greene; nieces and nephews, Kevin J.
