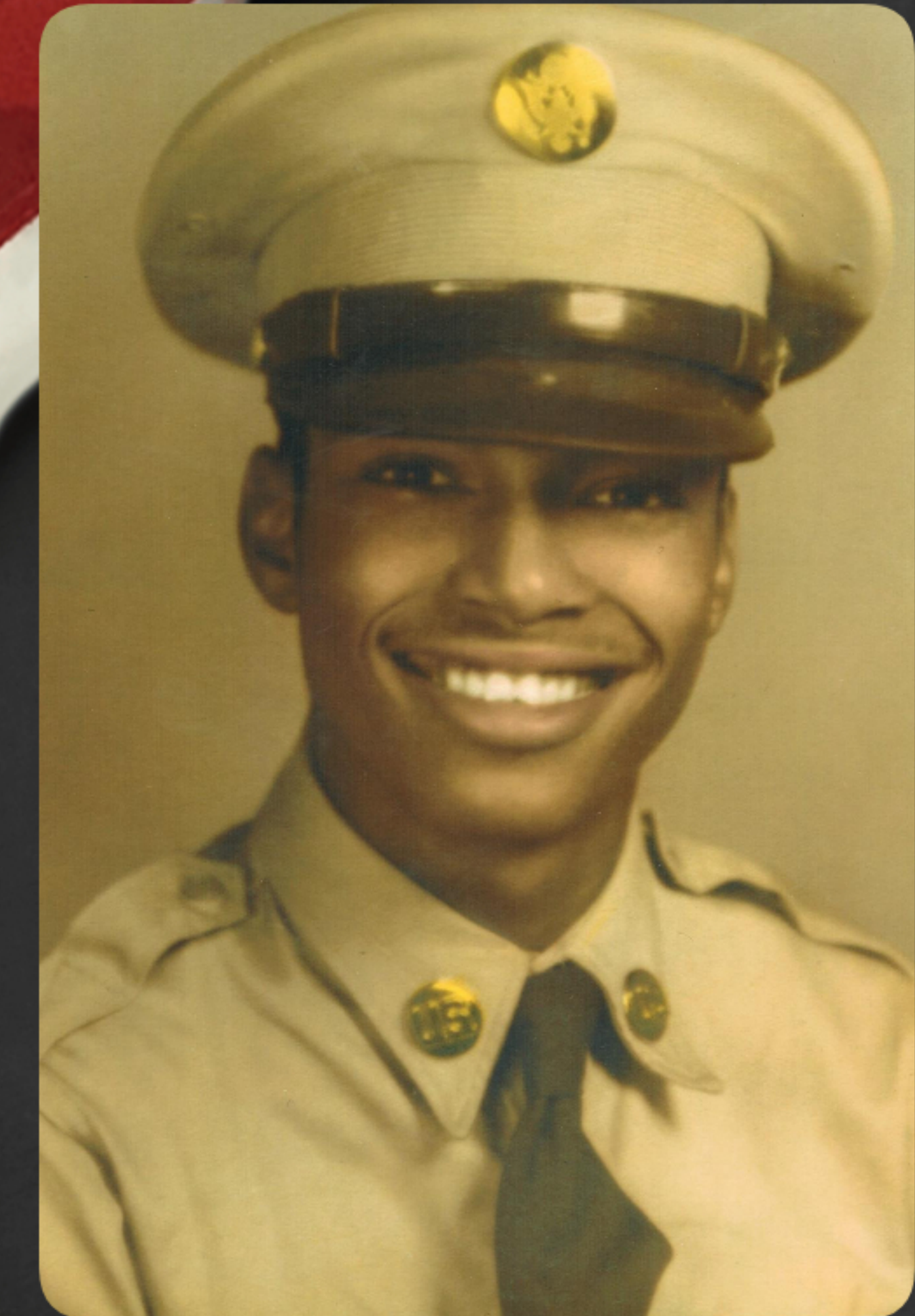

Obituary

Sanford Elliott Brown Jr., 88 was born on September 14, 1934 in Phebus, Virginia to the union Velna and Sanford Brown Sr. He departed this life on November 27, 2022 into the arms of the Lord.



He moved from Virginia to Knoxville, Tennessee where his father was stationed with the military. He attended school in Knoxville and later joined the U.S. Army to serve his country during the Korean conflict. Sanford returned to Cincinnati following his discharge. Upon his return, he held various jobs one of which was driving a taxi. In 1975 he started Emerald Taxi Co, which he operated with his wife for more than 25 years. During that time, he employed more than 30 drivers and provided reliable transportation to countless Cincinnatians.



During his spare time, Brown enjoyed fishing with his wife and children. He also enjoyed attending Hughes High School basketball games where his daughter coached. He was a homebody; occasionally went out to shows.



He was preceded in death by his parents, Velna Brown and Sanford Brown Sr.; his daughter, Shandra Brown and sister, Sandra Flowers.
