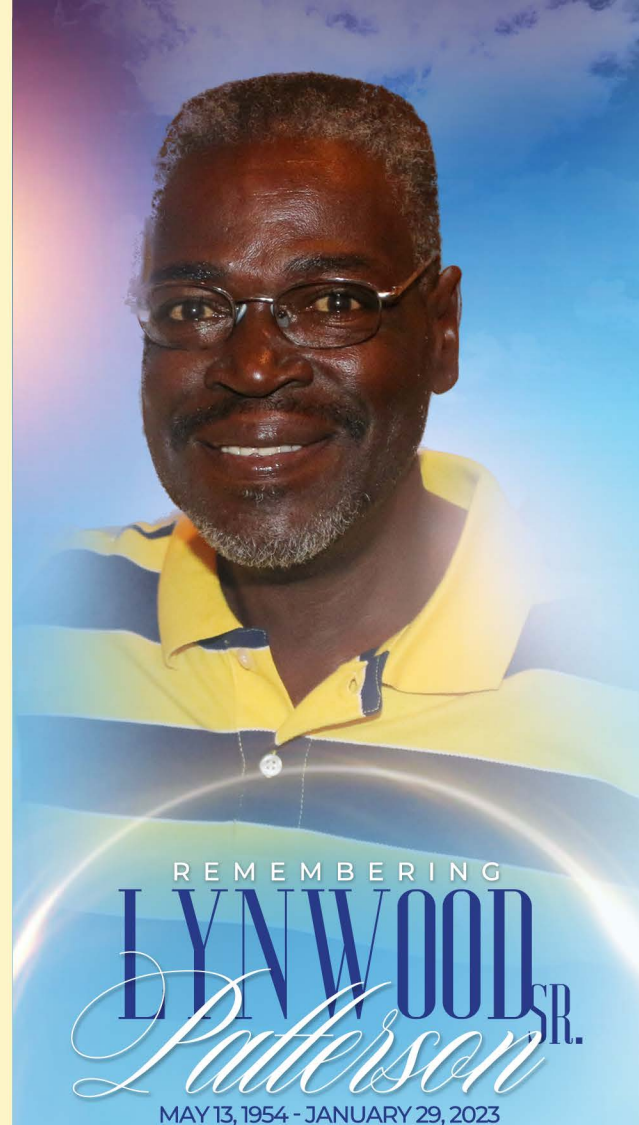

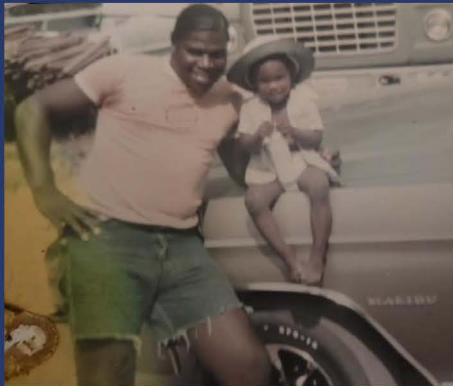

Mr. Lynwood Patterson, Sr. was born on May 13, 1954, to the late Lenon and Ruby Patterson in Wade, NC. He transitioned from labor to reward on Sunday January 29, 2023.

As the eldest of six children, Lynwood attended Central High School, where he was one of the first black students to attend. He later transferred and graduated from Cape Fear High School in 1972. Upon graduation, he was employed with ICI Incorporation for over 25 years. After completing his tenure with the company, Lynwood began driving tractor-trailers for Schneider Trucking Company. In his later years, he and his life-long best friend became co-owners of Ramsey Street Detail Shop. Together, they have served the community for the past 18 years.

At an early age, Lynwood gave his life to Christ and became a member of Sandy Grove Freewill Baptist Church. He enjoyed hearing good preaching and wonderful singing. In his spare time, Lynwood enjoyed bowling, basketball, music, riding motorcycles, playing pool, and most importantly, being around family and friends. Lynwood was extremely intentional and passionate when interacting with others. If you had the pleasure of experiencing him, he would never let you go without telling you that he loved you at the end of every conversation. The smile on his face after he uttered those words will forever leave an impression in all our hearts.

Lynwood is preceded in death by: His parents, Lenon and Ruby Patterson; his son, Lynwood Patterson, Jr.; his sister, Ruby Lee Patterson; and his brother, Frankie Patterson.
