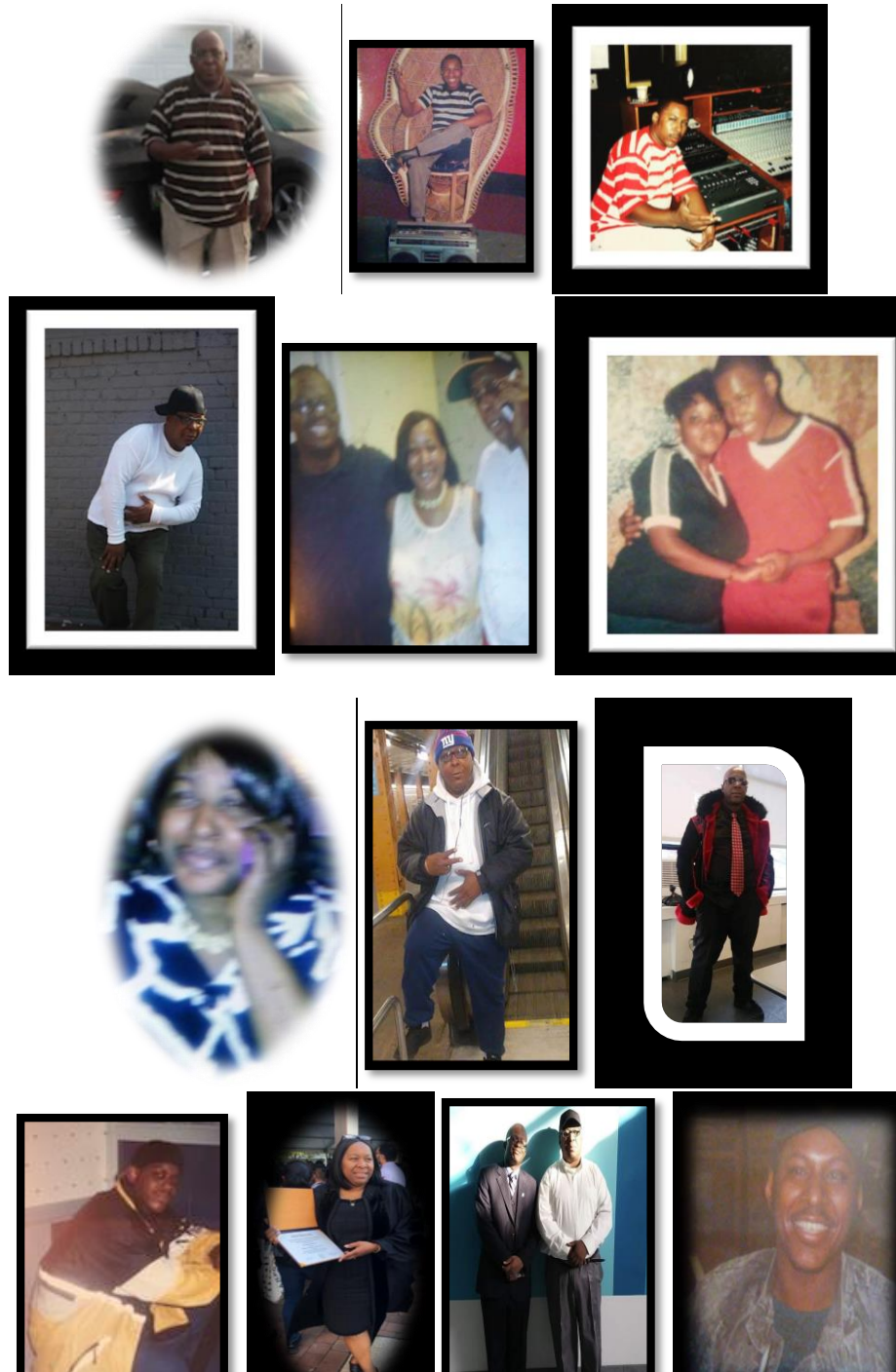
OBITUARY
