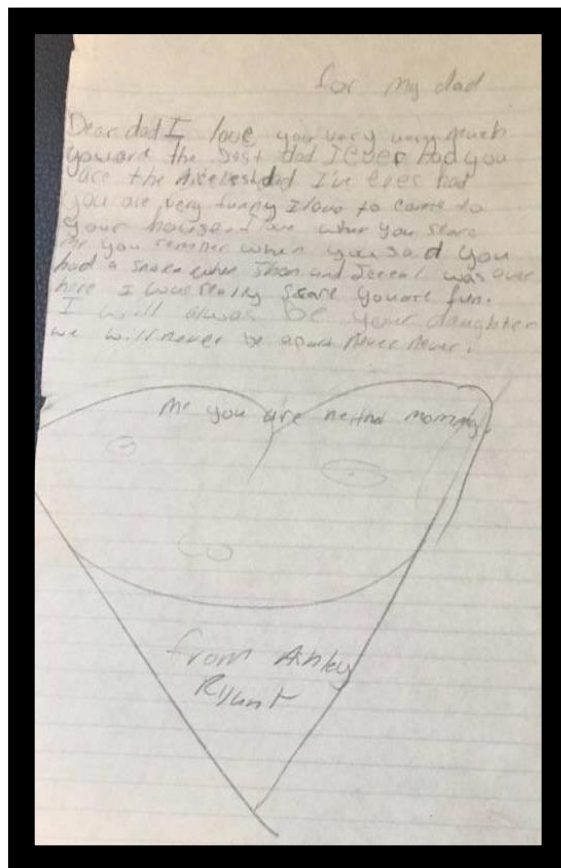

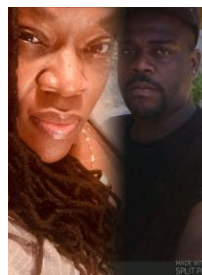

"A TIME TO BE BORN"

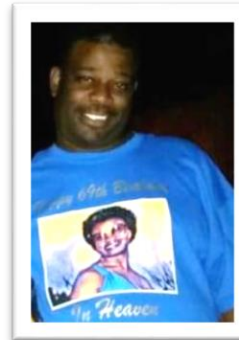
Stanley Tyrone Greene was born on September 6, 1972, the only child of the late Mabeline Greene and Ronnie Joe Wright.
