Obituary

Mrs. Leonne Butler Crosson was born on July 15, 1925, in East Gulf, West Virginia, to Willie Beatrice Scott and Oscar Chandler. She departed this life at the age of ninety-three, on Monday, September 24, 2018 at J.F. Hawkins Nursing Home.

Leonne was raised in West Virginia, Virginia and Maryland. She graduated from Conley High School in Mullens, West Virginia, in 1943, after which she relocated to New York City.

She was a member of Samuel Lymens Lutheran Church in New York City.

On December 21, 1943, she was united in Holy Matrimony to Freeman L. Butler. That union produced one daughter, Joyce Kim. Freeman died on June 12, 1982.

Mrs. Crosson retired as a Supervisor with Revlon after thirty plus years of service on December 18, 1987.

In 1990, she married George L. Crosson. They first moved to Columbia, South Carolina, and then settled in Newberry, where George was born. She joined Bethlehem Baptist Church under the leadership of James A. Williams. She was active in the Pulpit Aid, Missionary and Sunday School Ministries. Additionally, she was a supporter of the Native People students attending The University of Massachusetts at Amhearst.

Leonne was God fearing and loved the Lord, her children, niece, extended family and the Bethlehem family, and to all who aided her in her twilight years.
