## *Obituary*

Mrs. Mildred C. Henderson was born in Newberry, SC, on September 11, 1923, to the late Elliott and Whittie Goree Caldwell. She entered into Eternal Rest on January 24, 2019.

As a teenager she became a follower of Christ. She was a devoted and faithful member of Fairview Baptist Church where she was a member of the Senior Choir and Adult Sunday School Class. Also, at one time, she served as Superintendent of the Sunday School and Church Clerk. She was a member of the AP and B Society and the Women's Home Aid Society.

She was a graduate of Drayton Street High School in Newberry, SC. After completing high school, she attended Spelman and Benedict Colleges. She received her BA Degree in Education from Benedict College. She did further studies at North Carolina AT&T and South Carolina State University.

She commenced her teaching career at a one room schoolhouse, Presley School, where she taught first through eighth grades. She also taught at Kitt Pleasant Hill School, Leitzsey School, Garmany Elementary School and Pomaria School. After teaching for thirty-one years, Mrs. Henderson retired in 1982, while teaching at Pomaria Elementary School. She did all of her teaching in the Pomaria area.

Mrs. Henderson was the last surviving member of her immediate family. Those who are left to celebrate her life and cherish her loving and precious memories include two daughters, Debra Brandon of Newberry, SC, and Vandora Henderson of Asheville, NC; son, Nesby E. Henderson (Geraldine) of Beaufort, SC; six grandchildren, Rashad, Danielle, Tiffani, Lasundra, Latoya and Nesby II; six-great grandchildren; and a host of nieces, nephews, cousins and friends.
