



## Reflections of the Life of Mr. Arthur Lee "Shim" Wheeler

Arthur Lee Wheeler was born August 27, 1949, in Prosperity, South Carolina, to the late James E. Wheeler and Alice Stephens Wheeler. On Thursday, October 17, 2019, he rested from labor to reward at WJB Dorn Hospice and Palliative Care Warriors Walk, Columbia, South Carolina.

Arthur was affectionately known as "Shim" or "Soul Dog" to many.
