I found my place at the close of day.

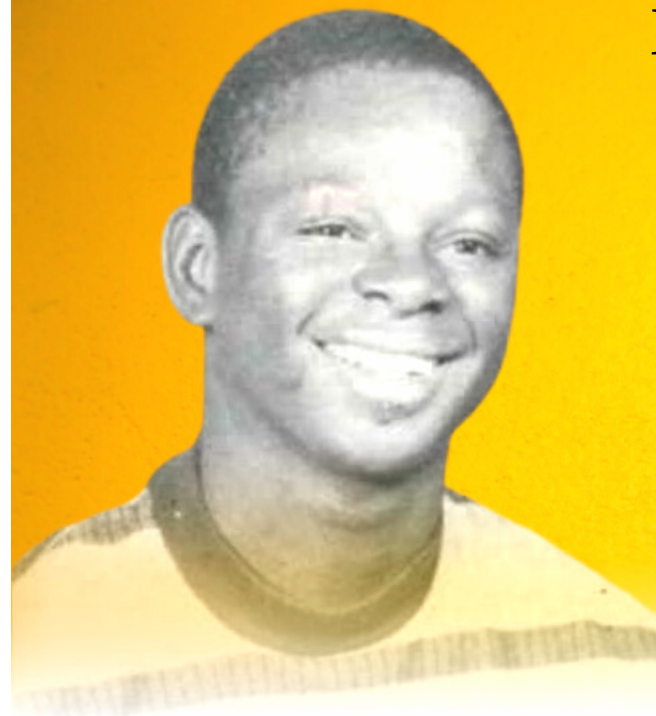
If my parting has left a void
