set me free in the reflections of Thee*

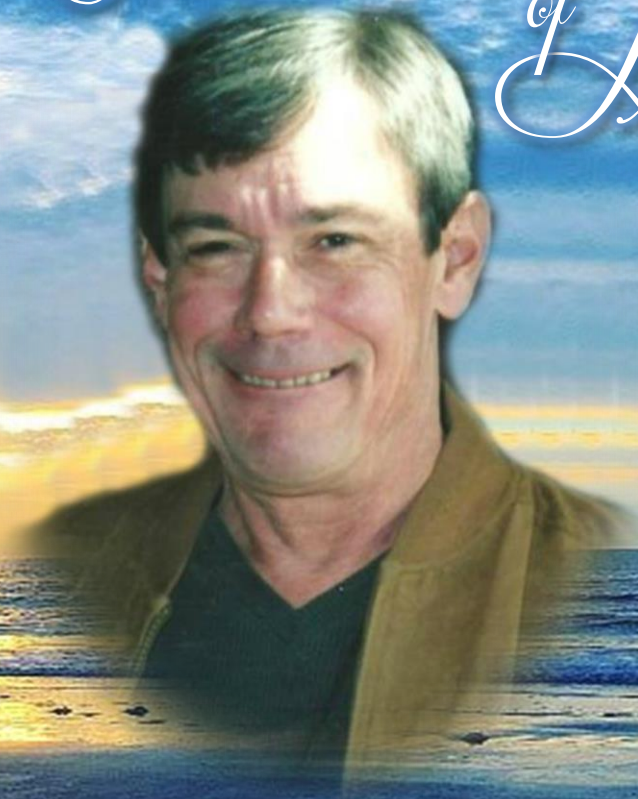
