

Eva “Marina” Blenner-Hassett, age 82, passed away on Thursday, April 25, 2019 at the Jubilee Lodge, Kinistino, SK. Eva Marina was born on December 29, 1936 at Saskatoon, SK, the only child born to Thomas & Mabel Norman. They lived in Raymore, Melville, and then Moose Jaw. She took her schooling in Moose Jaw and graduated from Moose Jaw Central Collegiate in 1955. Marina became a Registered Nurse in 1958 and worked as a psych nurse in Moose Jaw and Edmonton. Her nursing career spanned from 1958 – 1963, at which time she began a new chapter in her life as a wife, mother, and homemaker. 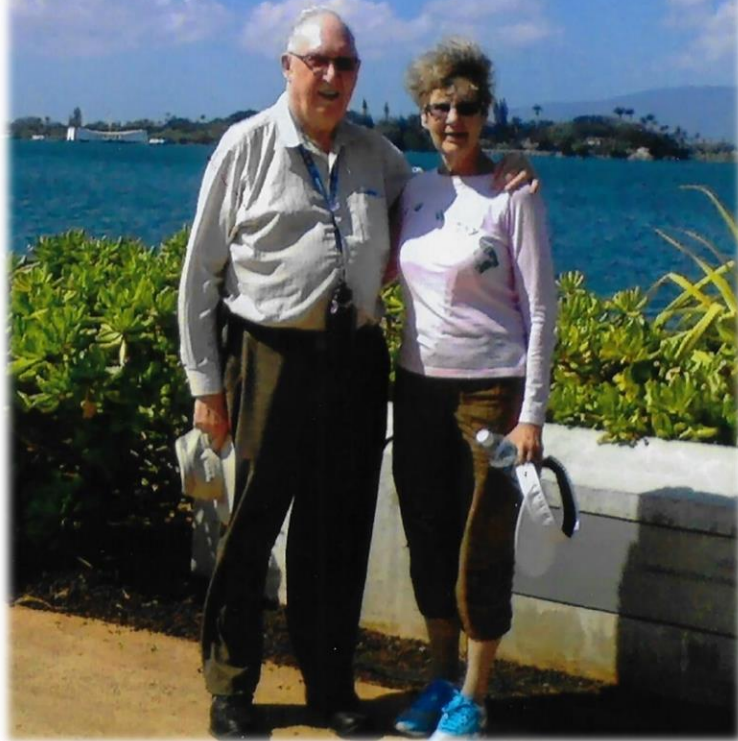
