

Anne Dyck, age 99 years and 5 months, passed away surrounded by her family on Thursday, February 20, 2020 at the Herbert & District Integrated Healthcare Facility, Herbert, SK. Anne was born to Aaron & Helena Lepp on September 17, 1920 in Russia. She and her sister, Katherine, along with her parents immigrated to Canada in the fall of 1926. The family stayed for a few months in Dominion City, MB before settling in Gouldtown, SK. On August 29, 1943 Anne married Abram Dyck. They farmed north of Morse until they sold the farm and bought a restaurant and service station in Ernfold. She did a lot of cooking and baking. Later, they moved to Waldeck, SK and Anne went to work at A&W. After a few years she retired from work, but still looked after her house and yard. She moved to Swift Current and then into the Herbert Manor. When her health began to fail, she moved into the Herbert & District Integrated Healthcare Facility. Anne is survived by her four children, Betty Zacharias, Martin (Agatha) Dyck, Elvera (Raymond) Hildebrand, and Gladys (Marven) Derksen; her thirteen grandchildren; her many great-grandchildren and great-great-grandchildren; her sisters, Helen Vogt and Mary Koop; her brother, Jake (Esther) Lepp; and by many nieces and nephews.
