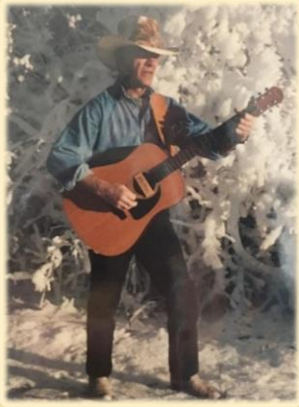

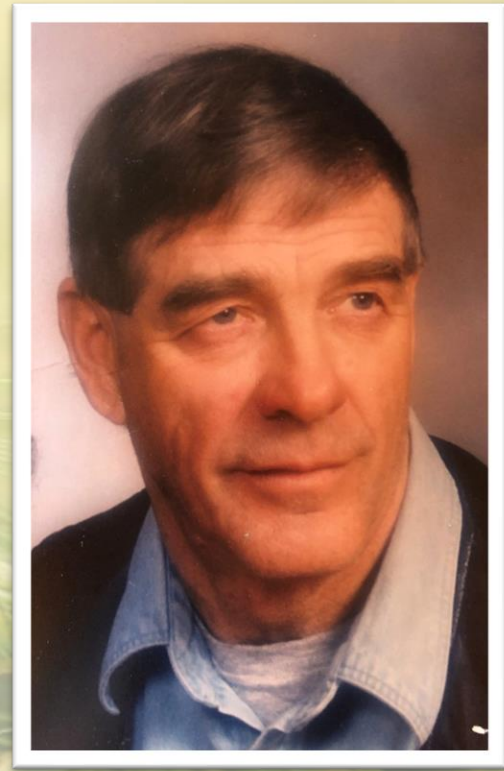


Remember him with a smile today, he was not one for tears. Reflect instead on memories of all the cherished years.
