Susie married Frank Zacharias of McMahon, SK on August 7, 1960 in the Chortitz EMC Church, where they faithfully attended and served for many years. She continued to teach Sunday School and served in other areas such as Ladies Aid making blankets to send overseas with MCC. Frank & Susie lived in the original house on the farm for three years until 1963. They then built a new house on the farm near McMahon. Here, they raised their family of six children — Sandra, Freda, Dennis, Connie, Verna, and Sheila. Susie enjoyed the farm life and was a very hard worker in everything that she did — gardening, canning, milking cows, raising chickens, sewing, crocheting, cooking hearty delicious meals, and baking for family and friends. Many people enjoyed coming for visits — they were always welcomed with warm hospitality and delicious food. Susie was known for her wonderful homemade buns, chocolate cake, and other goodies and jams — there was never a shortage of food. When people came for fropa or other meals, everyone enjoyed the fellowship around the table. As busy as life was for her on the farm, she always had a smile on her face and cherished all the times together as a family — whether it was working, attending church, or having a meal. Susie’s gentle and quiet ways as she served others around her was a true gift and a godly example.
