

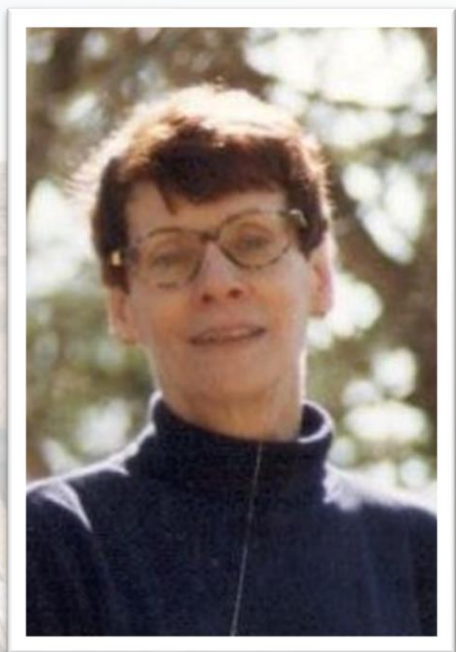
## This World Is Not My Home
