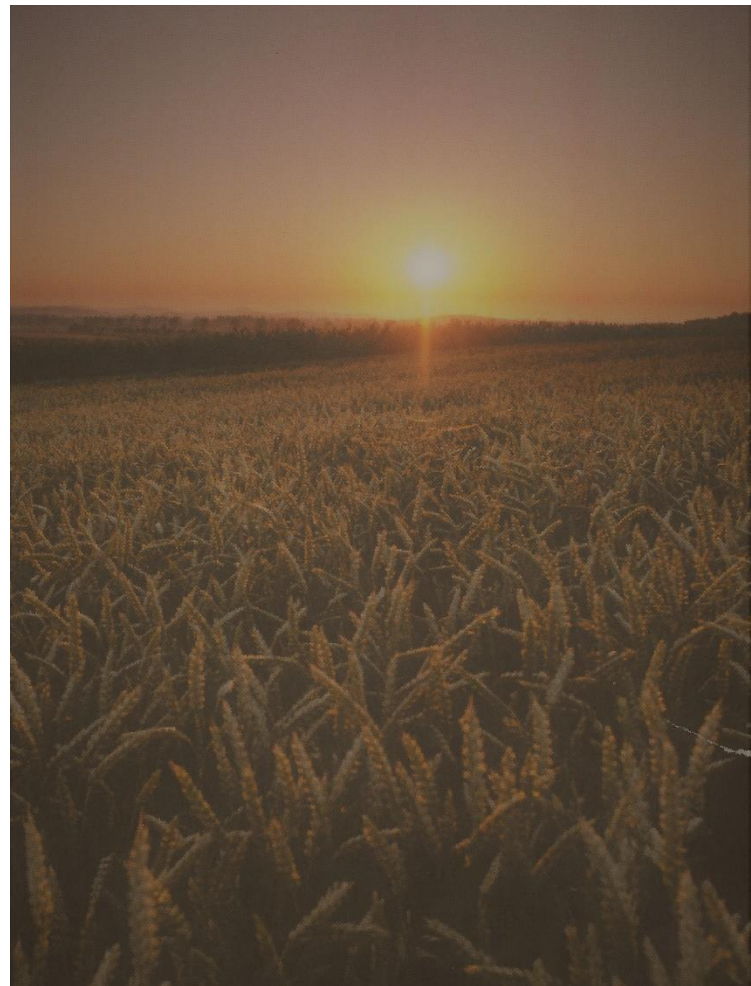


## God is in All My Tomorrows
