Jimmy W. O'Brien, 67, of Ogallala, died Wednesday, May 4, 2016, in the Ogallala Community Hospital.

Jimmy Wayne O'Brien was born December 14, 1948, in Corpus Christi, Texas, the son of Obbie and Agnes (Kalisek) O'Brien.

He graduated from W B Ray High School in Corpus Christi. Jimmy was drafted into the Army and served from March 24, 1966 to March 4, 1969.
