

Lois Jean Fillmer August 25, 1934 – November 29, 2016

Lois Jean Fillmer, 82, longtime Ogallala resident, died Tuesday, November 29, 2016, in her home.

Lois was born August 25, 1934 in Norfolk, NE, the daughter of Harold and Harriet (Dinges) Frohloff.

She graduated from Norfolk Senior High School in 1952 and from Norfolk Junior College in 1954 with an Associate of Arts degree. During high school and college days she was employed at F W Woolworth Store in Norfolk. Lois taught school for three years at Zion Lutheran School in Pierce, NE.
