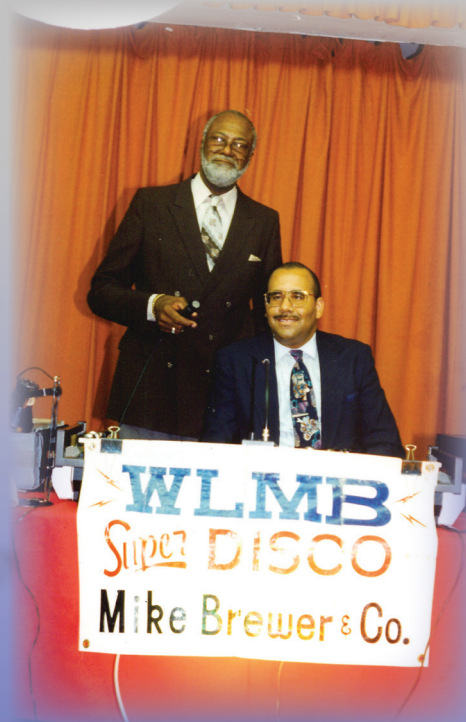

Lawrence Michael Brewer was born to the late Mary A. Brewer on September 18, 1934 in Washington, D.C.

He was educated in the District of Columbia Public Schools. He attended Shaw High School (later closed). He loved to play baseball. He attended trade and Industrial Schools for electronics and television after High School.

He volunteered to serve his country in the United States Air Force. He entered the Air Force on September 17, 1952. He was trained as an aircraft mechanic. He served in Denver, Colorado; Albuquerque, New Mexico; Air force Special Weapons Center Kirkland Air force Base New Mexico and Hawaii. He was honorably discharged on September 17, 1960.

Michael was employed by the Federal Government by the Department of Health Education and Welfare. He served there for over thirty years before he retired. He also became a successful Disk Jockey for the Washington Metropolitan area entertaining at cabarets and celebrations. Michael also had a public television program. He interviewed and entertained guests.

Michael was a member of Holy Redeemer Catholic Church where he served as a lector and a member of the Holy Name Society. He was an active member of the Church before he suffered a stroke.
