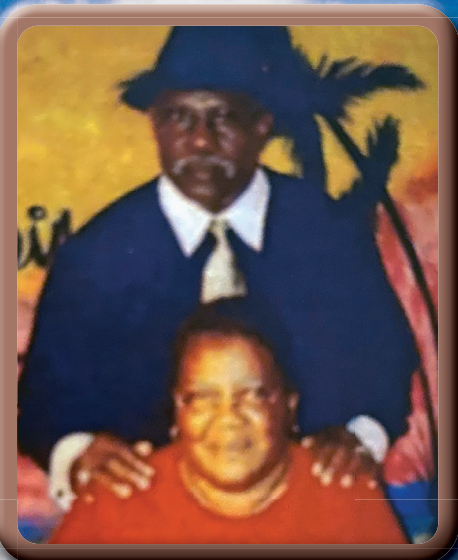


IN LOVING MEMORY OF
