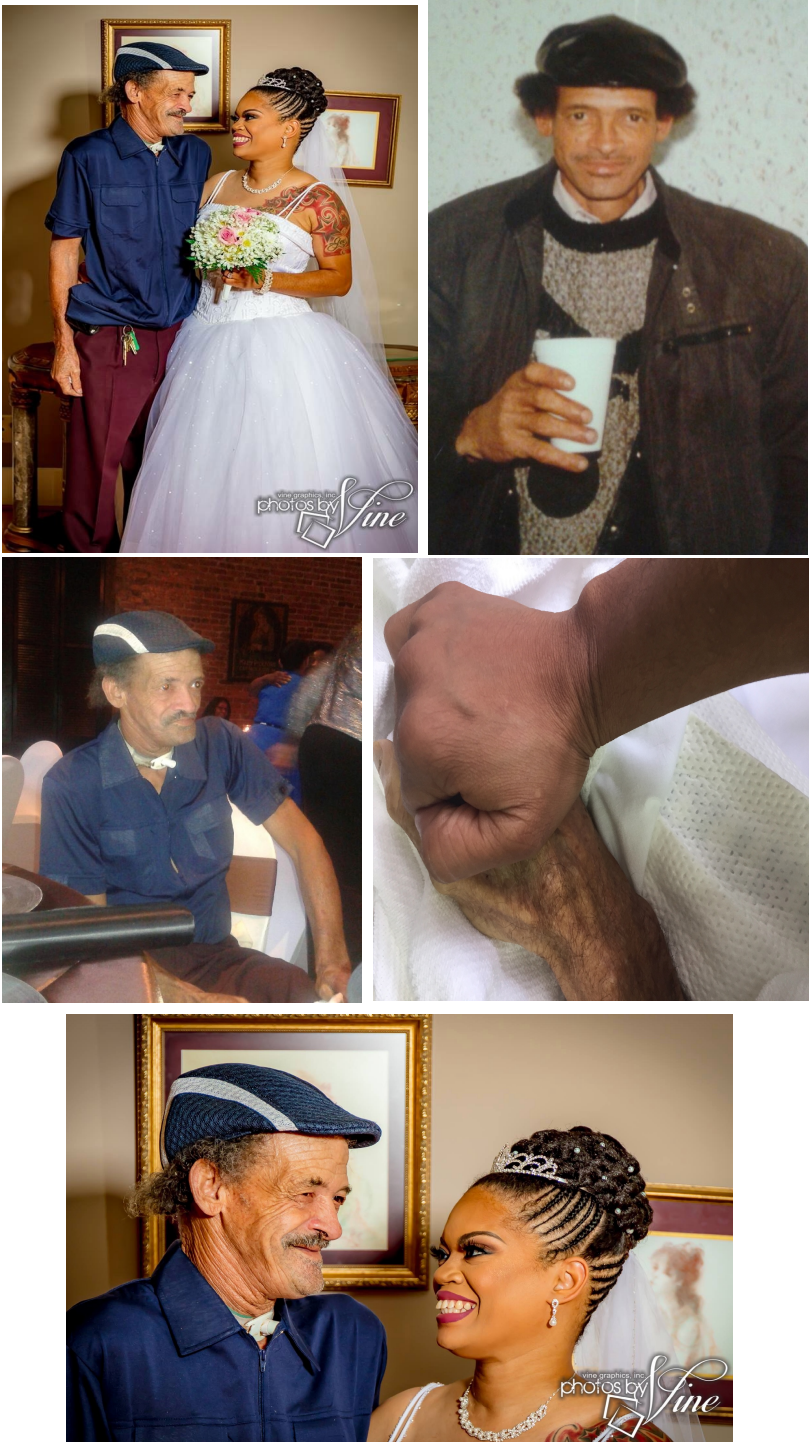
The Obituary
