

Dr. Kathy Ann Anderson Edwards was born to the late Julius Thomas Anderson and Cora Bracey Anderson on March 21, 1962 at Camden Memorial Hospital.

She was educated in the Kershaw County School system where a passion for medicine and assisting others developed. Kathy began training in the nursing program at Kershaw County Vocational School in her senior year at Camden High School. After graduating in 1980 she attained a Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) certification while working as a Candy Striper at Kershaw County Memorial Hospital. After five years, she received a scholarship to continue her education at Midlands Technical College and completed course work and acquired Registered Nurse (RN) certification, graduating as the Valedictorian of the RN program.

Kathy worked as a charge nurse at Richland Memorial Hospital in Columbia SC before returning to complete her undergraduate degree at the University of South Carolina. Kathy continued her professional education matriculating to the University of South Carolina School of Medicine specializing in Internal Medicine, acquiring a Doctor of Medicine (MD) in 1995. Kathy subsequently completed her residency at the University of Pittsburgh Medical Center at Shadyside Hospital, where she served as chief resident.
