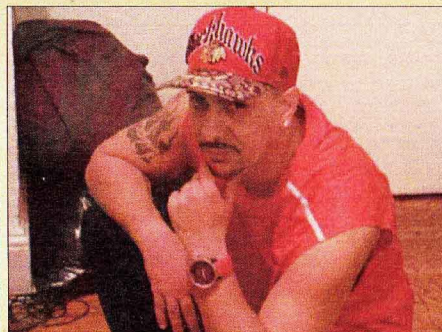


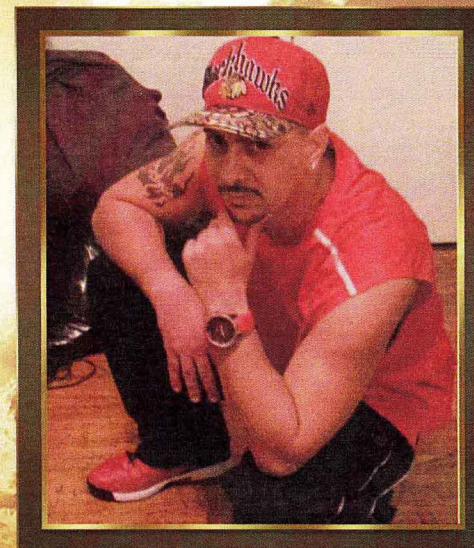

the love of God for us.

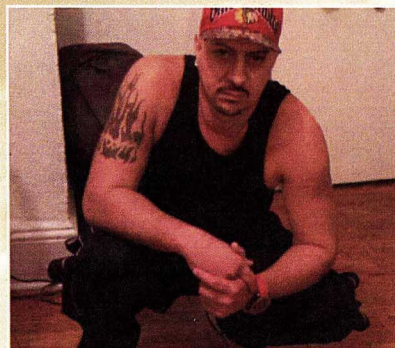
