Sean was born on September 01, 1967 to Benjamin and Elizabeth Chambers in Tuscaloosa, Alabama. He attended schools in the Tuscaloosa city School System, graduating from Central High school in 1985.

Sean joined the United States Navy in March 1986. He received an honorable discharge in April 1994. While in the Navy he received several commendations, including the National Defense service Medal Sea Service Deployment Ribbon with 2 bronze stars, Navy Battle "E" Ribbon, USCG Special Operations Service Ribbon with 2 bronze stars, and a Good Conduct Medal. He had nearly 2 years of sea duty, spending time on the USS Jesse L. Brown and the USS Stark.

After being discharged from the Navy, *Sean* returned home. He accepted Christ and joined the Weeping Mary Baptist Church under the pastorate of Dr. J. L. Simpson. He was baptized on February 5, 1995.
