Life Reflections

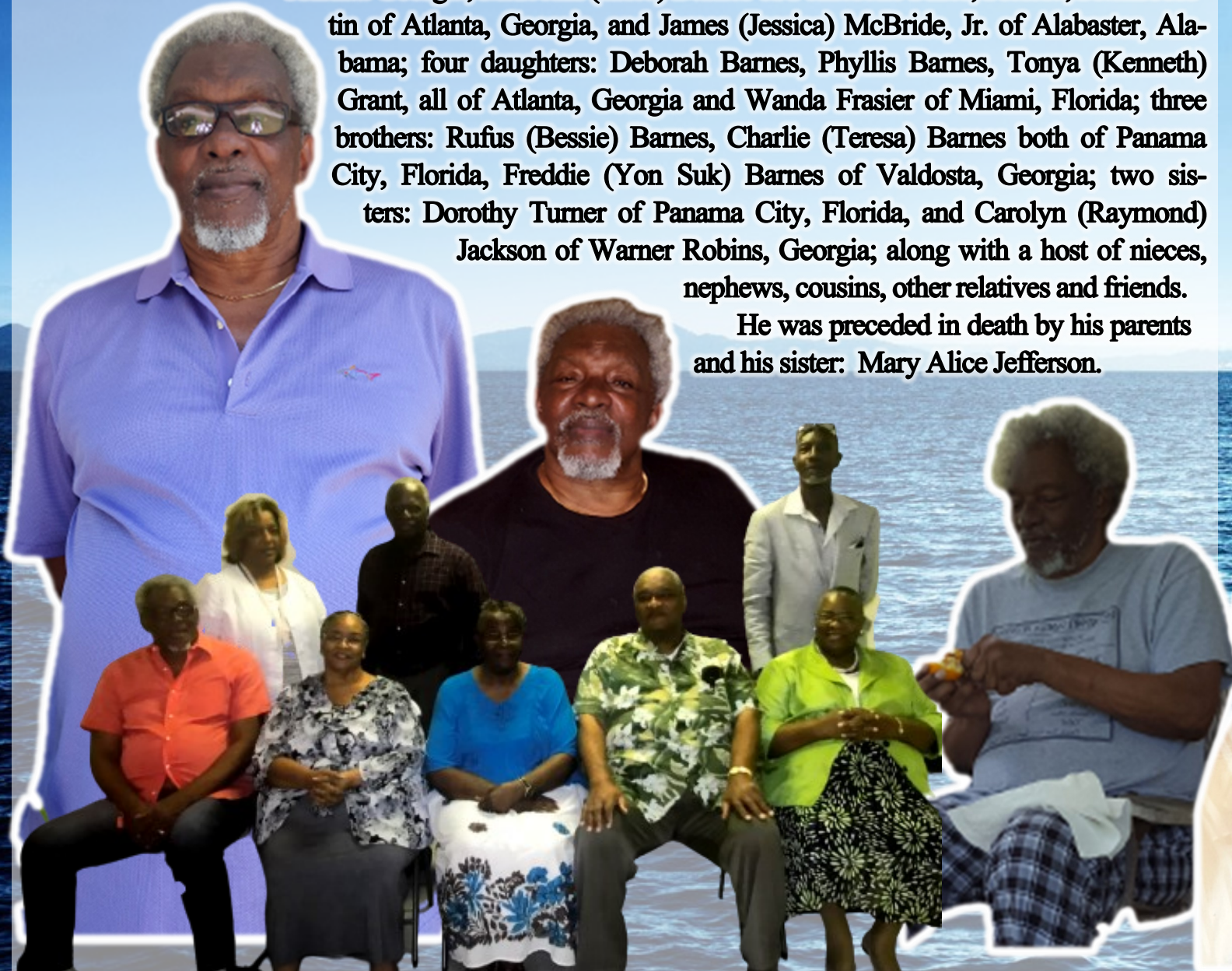
