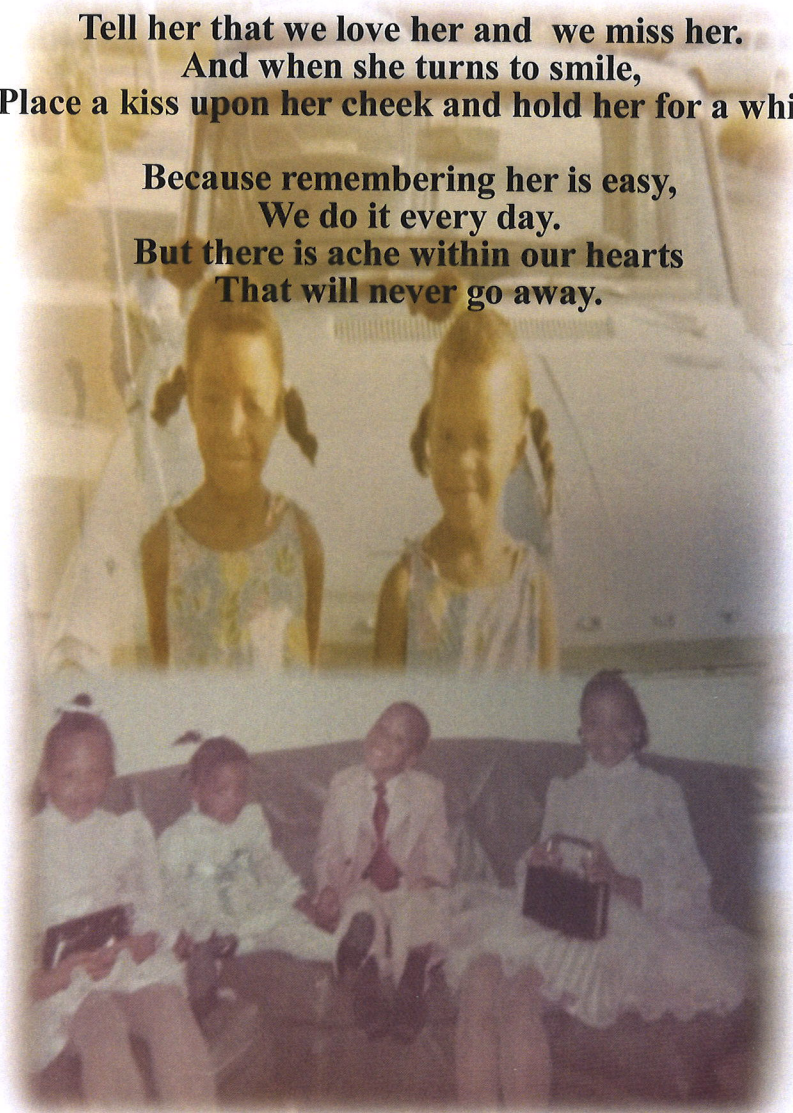


We Love you Marilyn
