

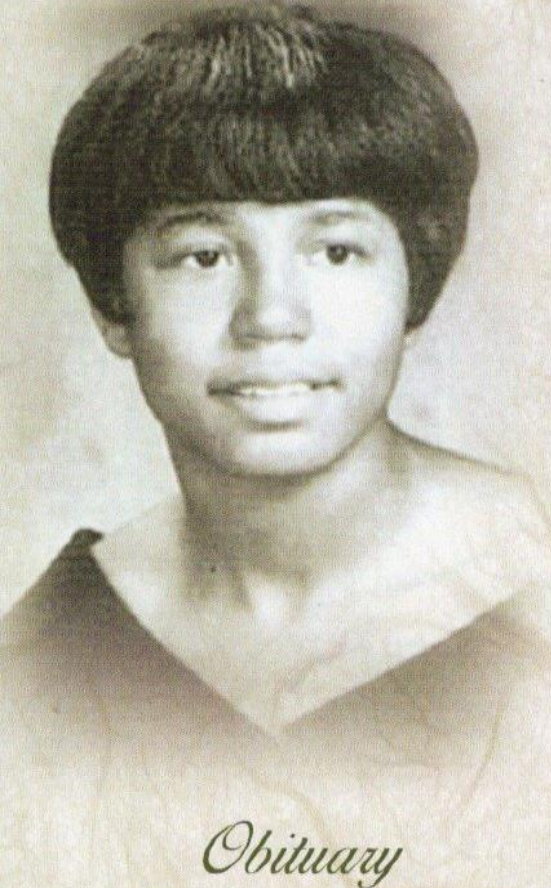

Drucilla, affectionately called "Dru," was a beautiful, generous, caring woman. Wherever she went, people were instantly drawn to her warm and kind spirit.

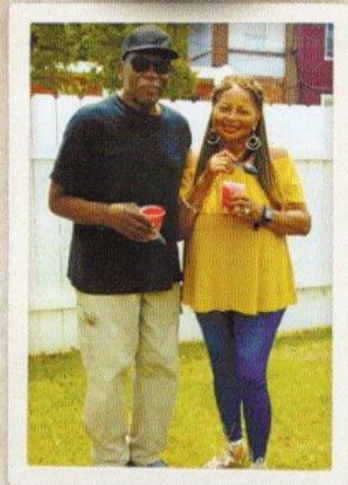

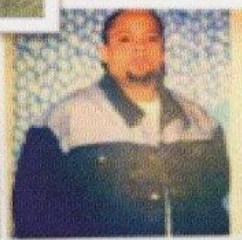
