Born in Coatesville, PA, she was the daughter of Lydia Ann Parker Butterfield and the late Herbert Jacobs.

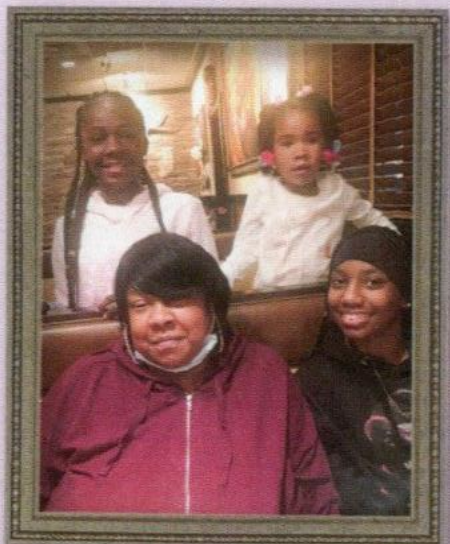


Parthenia was a 1981 graduate of Coatesville Area Senior High School, where she holds a track record in the girls 100-yard dash.

Parthenia was a nice person who had a kind and caring spirit. This was evident by the many people who called her "MOM."

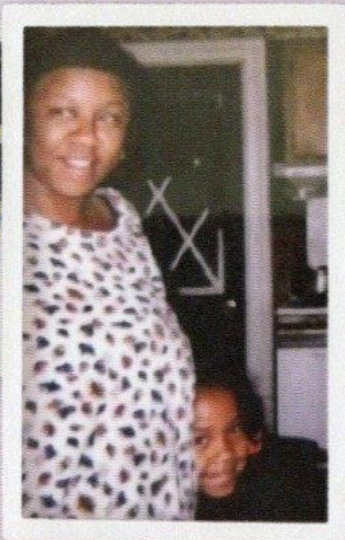
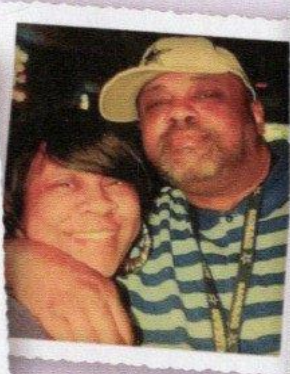

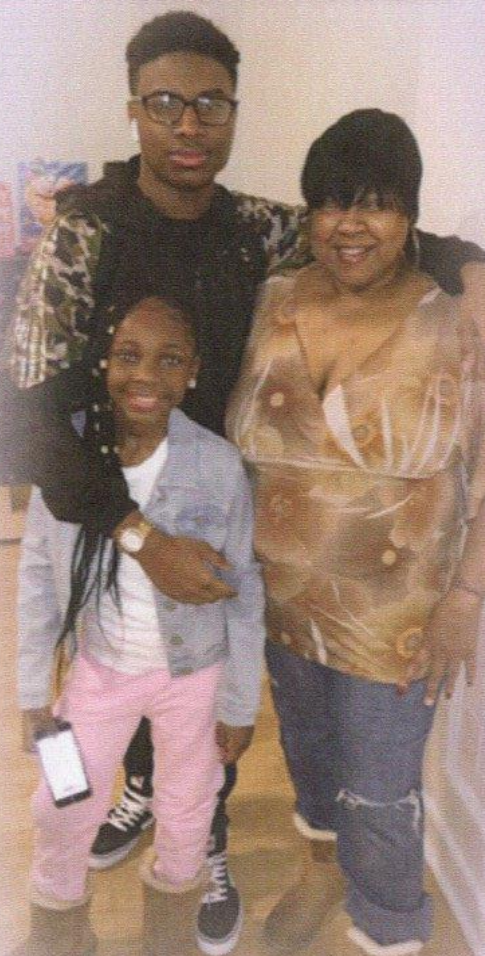
