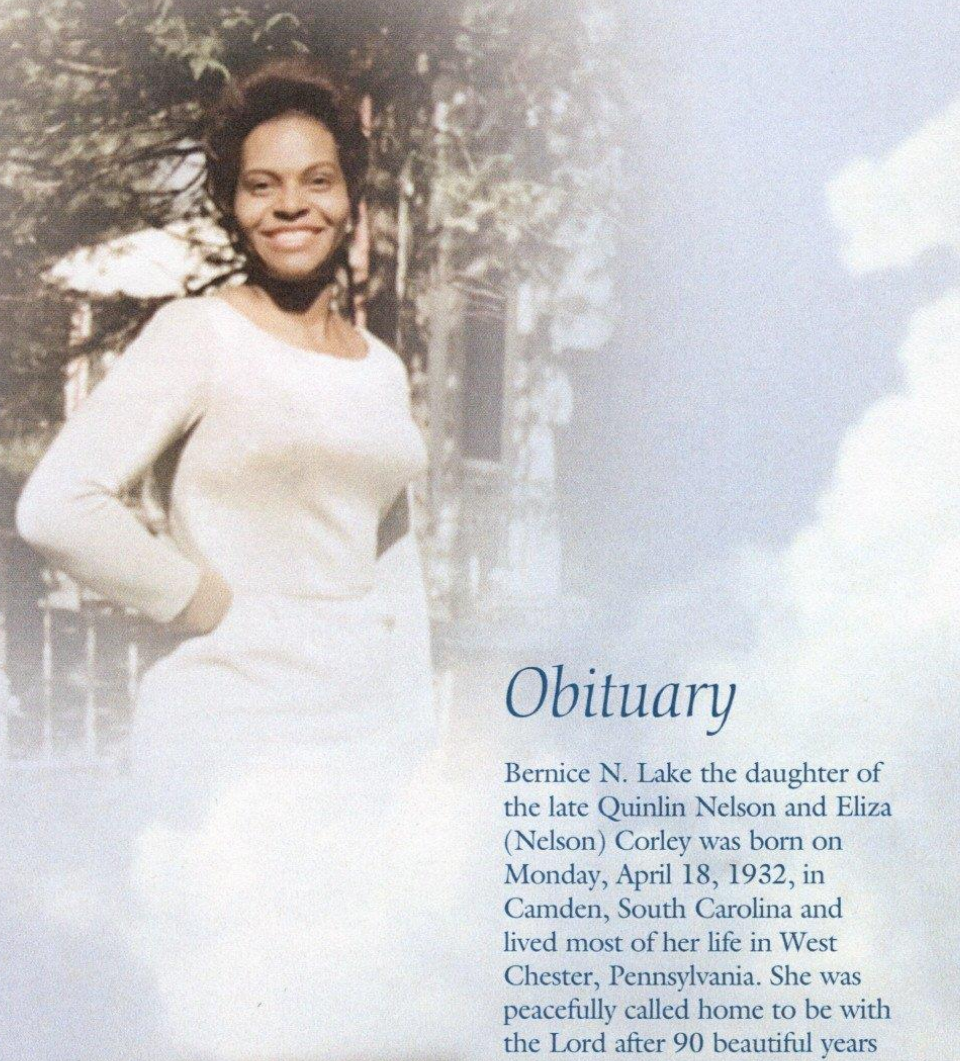

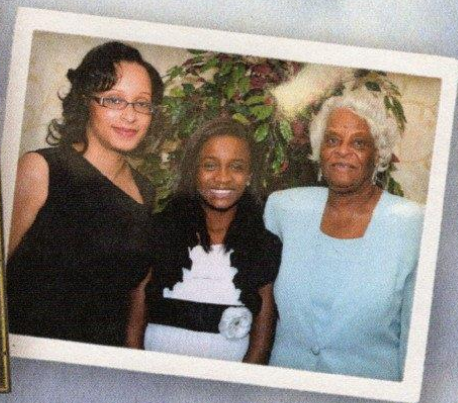
Bernice Lake

April 18, 1932 – May 13, 2022



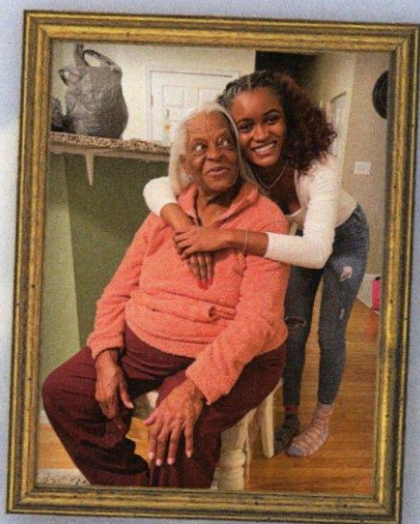
Obituary

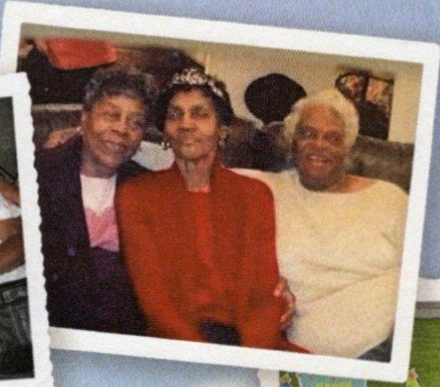
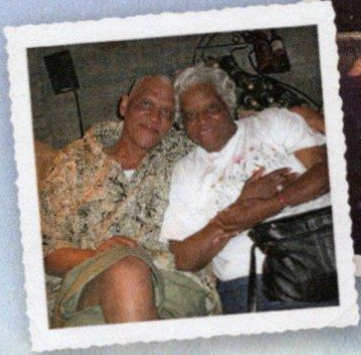

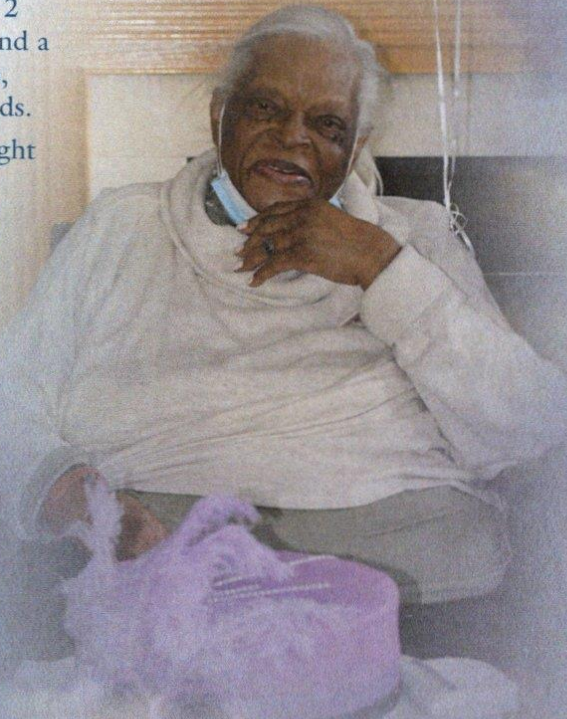
