Obituary

Henrietta Delores Jemison, 98, of Coatesville, PA, passed away on Wednesday, May 10, 2023, at Chester County Hospital in West Chester.

Born in Coatesville, she was the youngest of eight children; five girls and three boys (that died at birth) of the late Henry and Anna Louella Partlow McCrumn.

Henrietta was the wife of the late Willie Jemison with whom she shared 32 years of marriage.



She graduated from S. Horace Scott High School in 1942. She attended Apex College of Beauty & Hairdress, graduated on March 26, 1947, and became a self-employed beautician. Over the years, she worked at Jamesway, in the cafeteria at the Coatesville VA Hospital, and at Embassy Suites.
