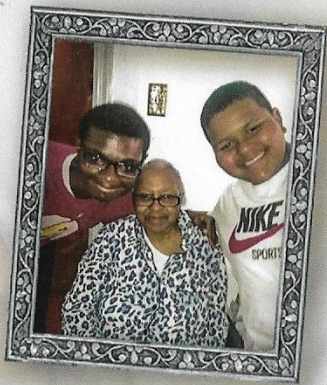


Marcella Vaughn
