In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by two brothers, David, and Joseph Butterfield.

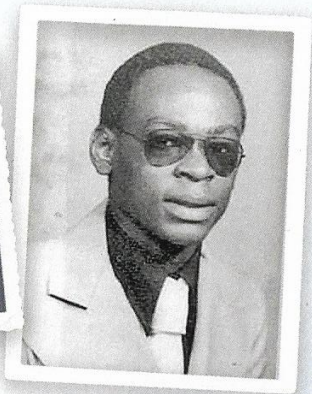
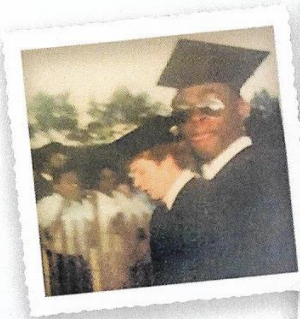
Darnell will be sadly missed but we will cherish his memory in our hearts.
