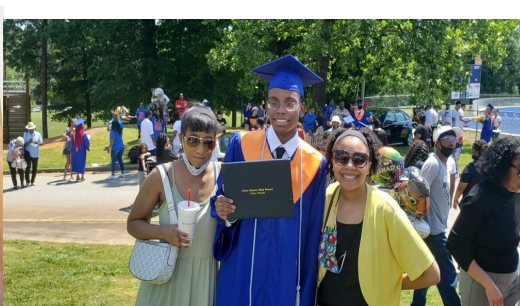
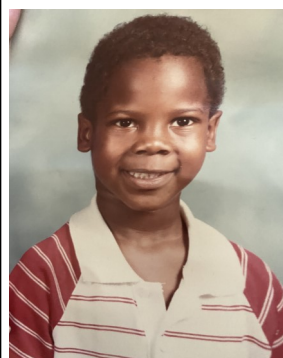
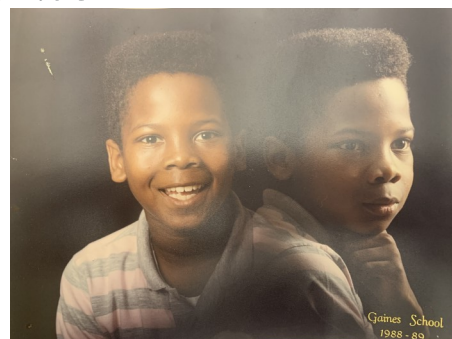
Obituary
