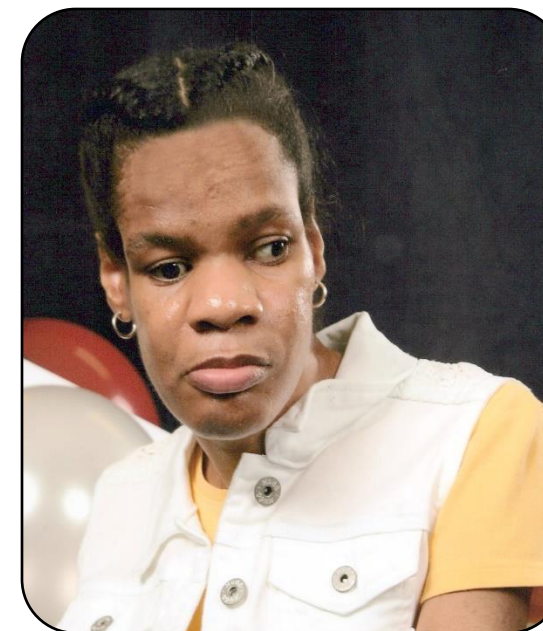
When Tomorrow Starts Without Me (Adapted)

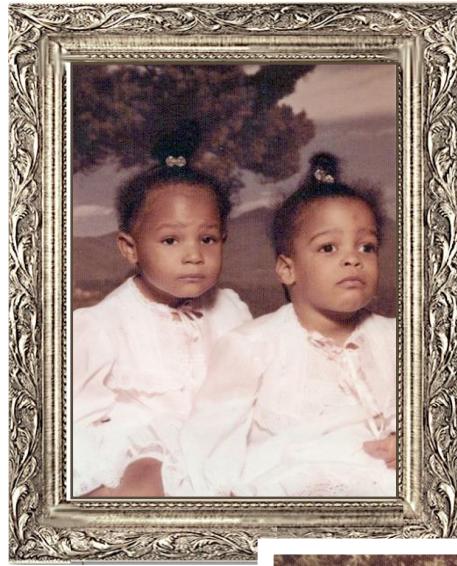
