You know I always will.

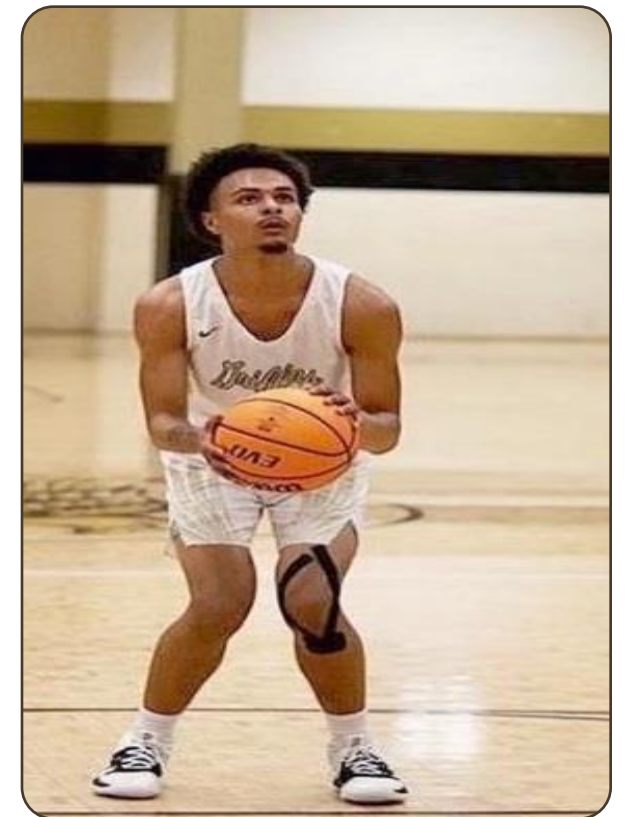
