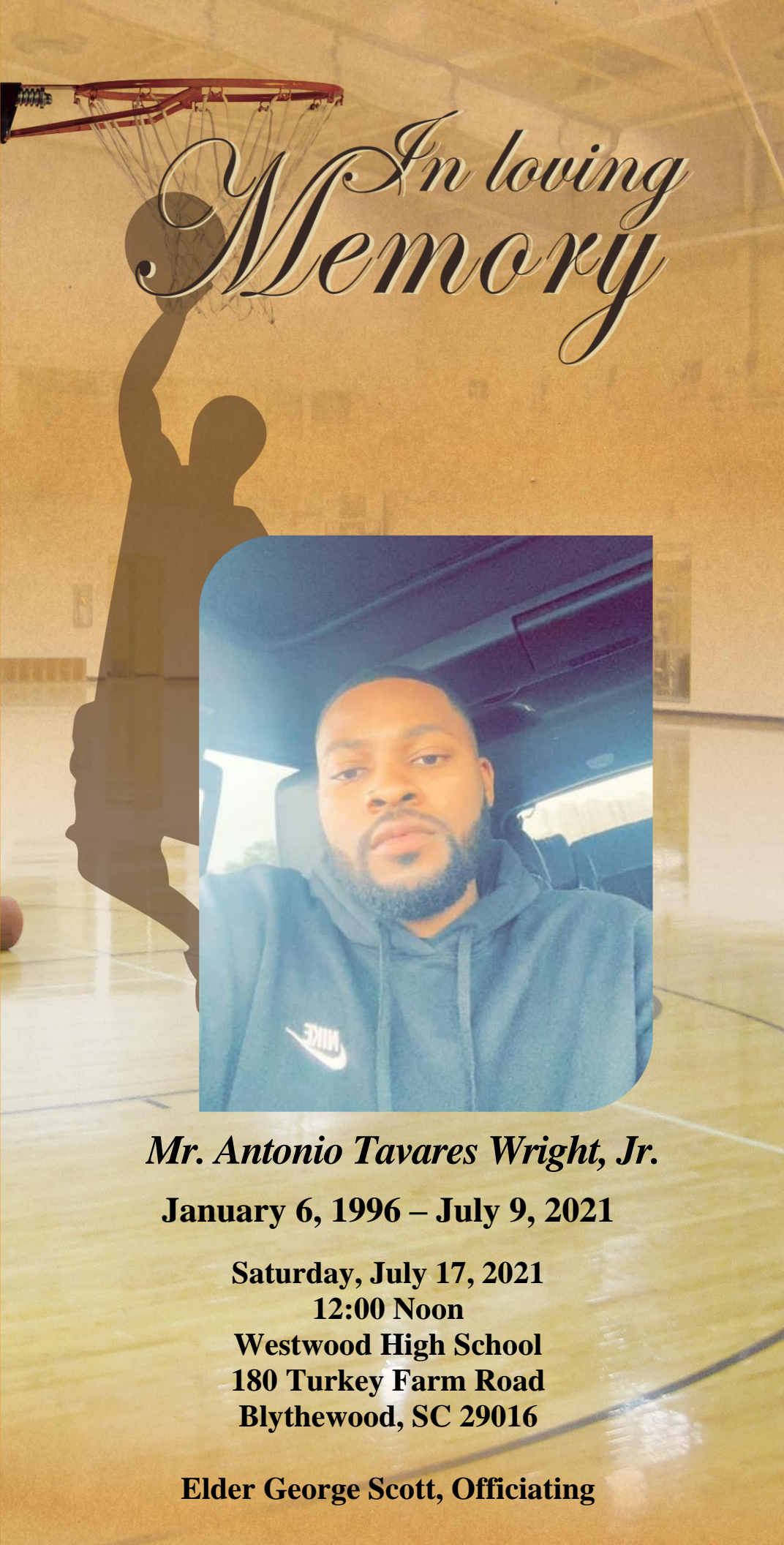
Miss Me – But Let Me Go
