While I’m still there, I can’t be dead.

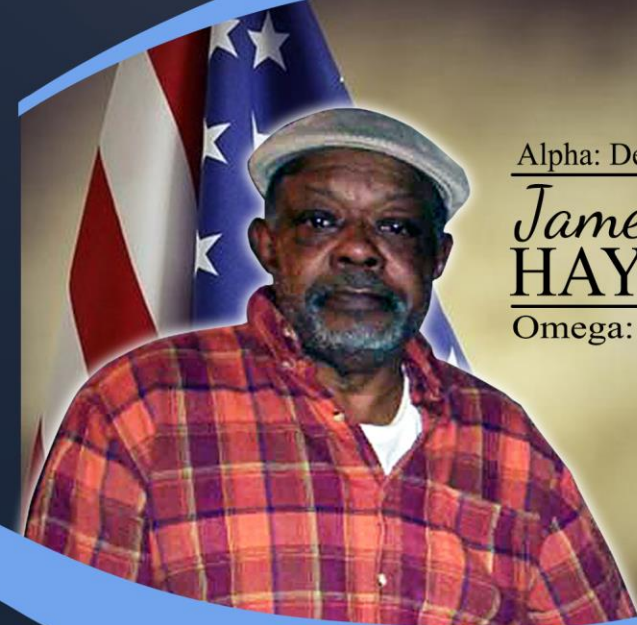
