## *Honoring Ruben's Life*

Retired Msgt Ruben O. Brawner completed his earthly assignment on Saturday, December 19, 2020 after a courageous battle with renal cancer.

MSgt Brawner was born in Elberton, Ga on July 5, 1948 to the parentage of John Lee and Ruby Pass Brawner. He was raised in a Christian household, committing his life at an early age.

Upon graduating from Blackwell Memorial High School in 1966, he immediately embarked on a military career by enlisting in the United States Air Force. MSgt Brawner enjoyed an extensive career, serving 24 years, garnering many honors and serving at numerous bases along the way. His final military assignment was to Robins AFB in Warner Robins, Ga. in 1989. He settled here upon retirement, and soon after began a Civilian career at Robins. He rose to the position of Quality Assurance Specialist working with C130 aircraft. He was still actively working in this capacity when health issues warranted another retirement after serving an additional 20 plus years.

MSgt Brawner was preceded in death by his parents and one brother, James Edwards.

He is survived by his wife of 45 years W.
