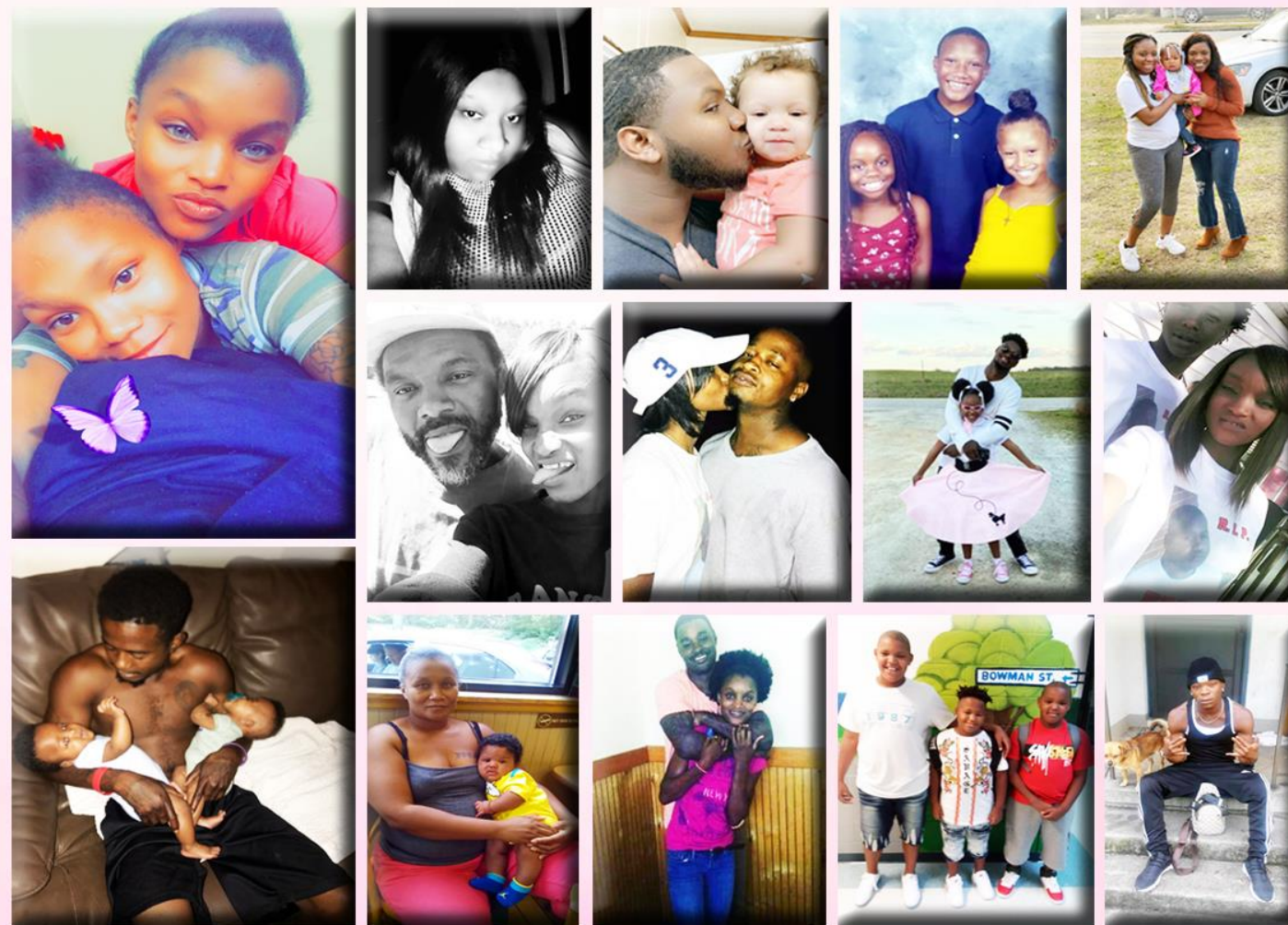
Honoring Breanna's Life
