Eileen Johnson, 87, lifelong resident of the Warren area, passed away on Monday morning, January 18, 2016, in North Valley Health Center, Warren, MN.

Eileen Marilyn Stinar was born on April 14, 1928, in Warren, to Thomas Jr. and Esther (Nelson) Stinar. She was raised in the Tabor area and attended grade school at the Farley Township Country School. Eileen graduated from Warren High School and went on to attend Aakers Business College in Fargo.
