Light for the way.

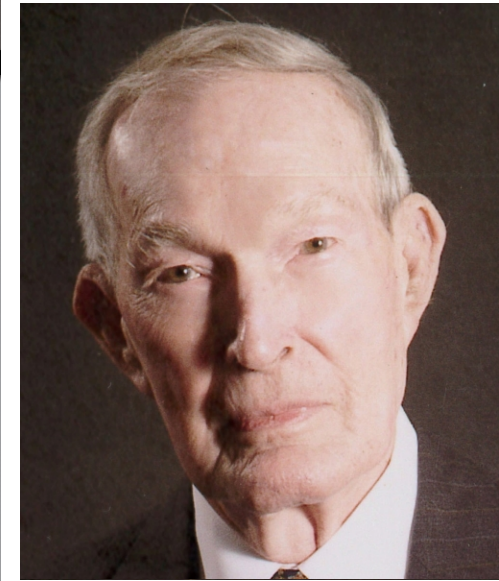
