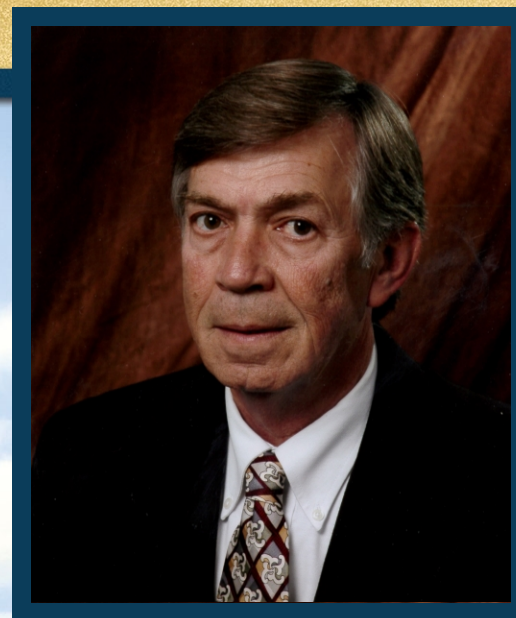

John Andrew Evans, age 70, resident of Oakland, Tennessee and husband of Laura Cook Evans, departed this life Friday morning, January 19, 2018 at the Baptist Memorial Hospital in Memphis.
