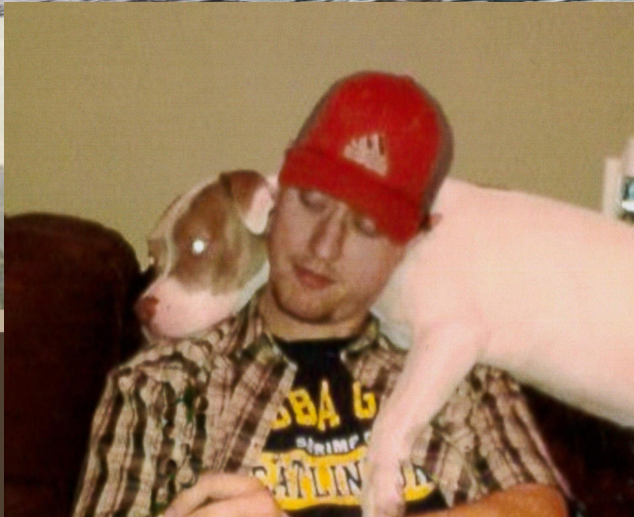




In Memory Of
