that is so missed when he's not there.

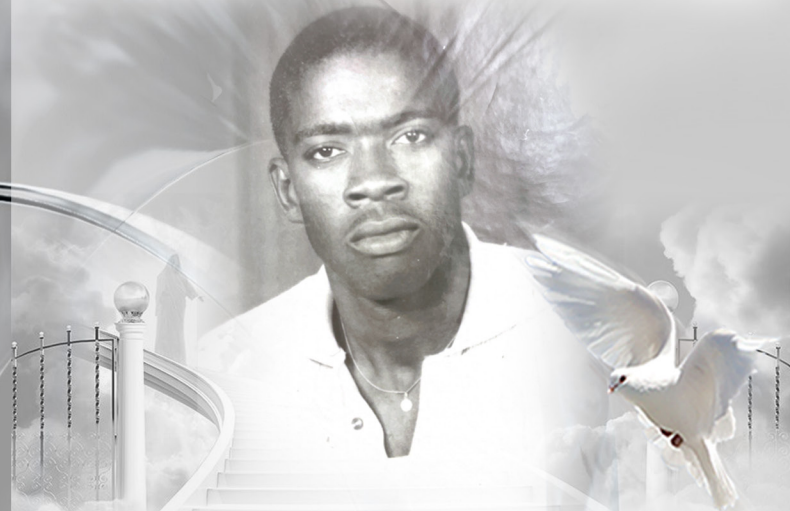
Take comfort he's in Heaven,
