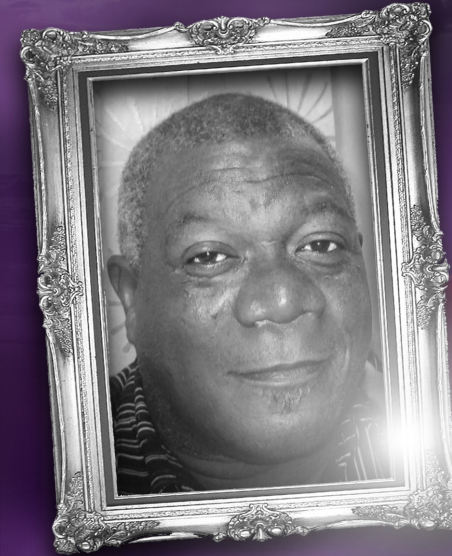

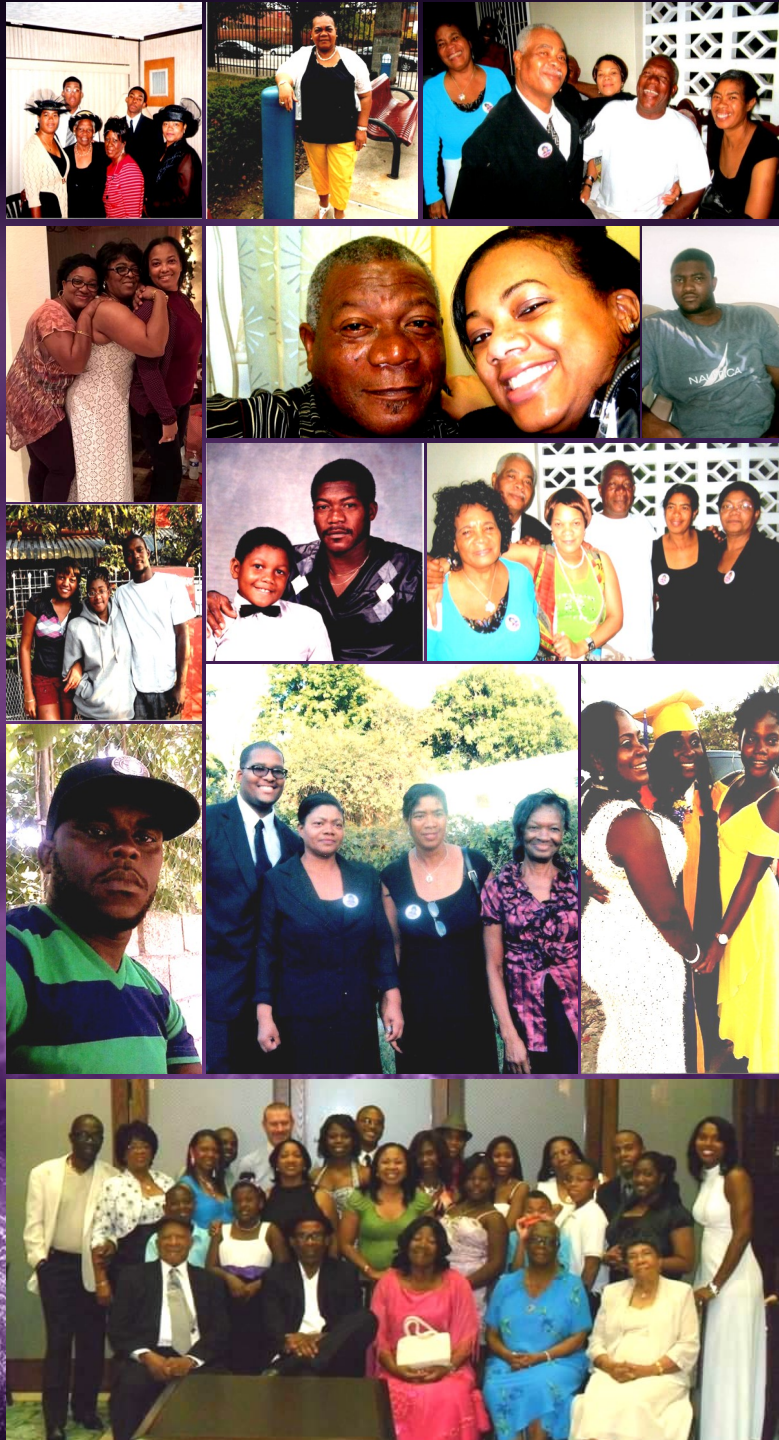


# Life's Journey
