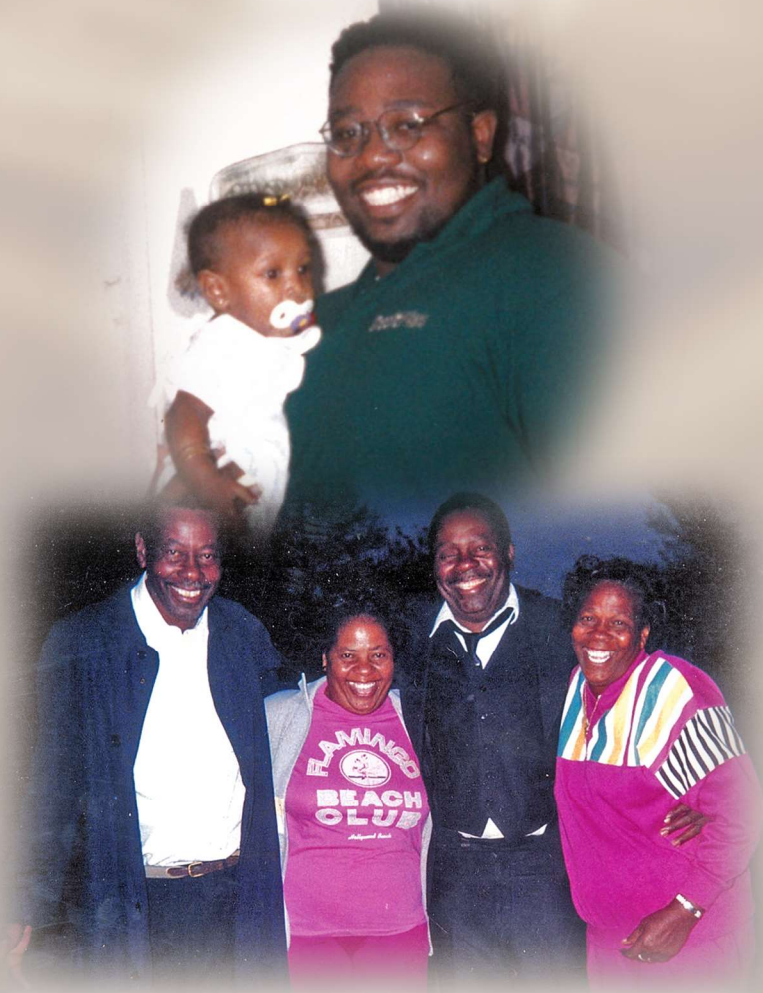


"DAD"
